

## ■ CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

- All participants are welcome to submit abstracts for the **moderated POSTER presentation**.
- We welcome abstracts on sportology. Sportology covers variety of the scientific approaches in related to sports, exercise, rehabilitation, neuroscience, philosophy, etc.

### How to submit abstracts:

- Abstracts should be prepared in **ENGLISH** and the presentation will be also in ENGLISH.
- Abstracts should be submitted **as the e-mail attachment**.
  - 1) Abstracts should include the authors, affiliations, title of the abstract and abstract body.
  - 2) Please underline the presenting author.
  - 3) Abstract body should be 600 words or less.
  - 4) One figure or table can be included, however, text should be 400 words or less in this case. Figure can be submitted in the picture format as a separate attachment to the abstract data.
  - 5) When submitting, the subject of the e-mail message should be, for example, 'ABSTRACT\_KawamoriR (Name of the applicant)' and the file name of the attached abstract should be the same.
  - 6) Be sure to include the posting address, phone number and fax number for the contact convenience.
- All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Program Committee on the basis of the scientific merit.
- All accepted abstracts will be included in the official Program and Abstract Book delivered to the participants on site.
- All accepted applicants will be requested to submit the full paper of the presentation so as to be included in the monograph published after the Congress. The paper will be approximately 2,500 words (including abstract but excluding references, tables and figures) in volume.
- A few 'Excellent Presentation Awards' will be awarded among the presented posters.

### Schedule:

**Duration of abstract submission:** October 1, 2010 – ~~December 24, 2010~~ → **January 11, 2011**

**Notification of the acceptance and detail of the presentation:** January 31, 2011

Note: **Presenting authors** whose abstracts are accepted are requested to **register for the Congress before February 15, 2011**.
